Minutes:

- **Motion made by Robert W. Nutting to approve minutes from January 15, 2014 as submitted. So voted. Motion passed unanimously.**

Chief Water & Sewer Operators Report:

- Jon is to look into a replacement computer for the plant. Brian Schlager mentioned that someone in the town is replacing one for their computers because of an interfacing issue; we might want to see if that would be an option for us.

- Larry Drew stated that he has a strong chlorine smell still. They have spoken with a neighbor who smells the same thing. Jon stated that we have the correct amount of chlorine in the water, it's not too high, it's the State required amount.
- **Motion made by Robert W. Nutting to accept the Chief Operators Report as written. So voted. Motion passed unanimously.**

Sewer - New Business:

Motion made by Robert W. Nutting to approve the Metayer-Gallerani Partnership permit application to connect to the sewer line. So voted. Motion passed unanimously

Sewer - Old Business:

- Sewer Flow Chart - Bridget handed out the flow chart as requested by Larry Drew. Brian pointed out a couple points of clarification on the bond payments.
- Bridget also handed out a list of those who have committed to hook on to the new sewer line, along with a listing of those who have refused and those who have not yet responded.
- The Selectboard wanted to make sure that the Commission is on board with the new sewer line to Plateau Acres for the Assisted Living Facility. The Commission is all for it, as long as they are involved every step of the way. It's very clear that the Assisted Living Facility will pay for the entire project.
